In connection with the computation of our Financial Proposal, are we going to follow the mandate of DOLE Department Order No. 150-16 setting the standard administrative overhead and profit margin at a minimum of twenty (20%) percent of the total cost? If so, will it disqualify the bidder who will not abide by the said twenty percent profit margin?	On this query, Procuring Entity adopts GPPB NPM resolutions 120-2016 and 89-2016 on the clarification on the application of the provisions of DOLE Department Order (DO) No. 150-16, dated 9 February 2016, entitled Revised Guidelines Governing the Employment and Working Conditions of Security Guards and other Private Security Personnel in the Private Security Industry. However, the Procuring Entity shall only award the contract if it is within the threshold set in the Approved Budget for the Contract of this particular requirement.
In the Statement of Ongoing government and private Contracts, do we need to attach the copies of the contracts stated therein or the matrix will suffice as compliance?	Supporting documents such as end user's acceptance or official receipt(s) or sales invoice issued for the contract are required to be attached in the Statement of Single Largest Complete Contract, however, bidders may still attach supporting documents for the Statement of Ongoing Government and Private Contracts. Please refer to the Section III. Bid Data Sheet of the Philippine Bidding Document.

Items not mentioned above remain the same.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is being issued to clarify/modify/amend the specifications of the requirement needed, and not for purposes of delaying the proceedings of RA 9184.
