#### **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

## Hiring of Testing Laboratories for the Microbiological and Nutritional Analysis of the NXTFOOD PH Products

### I. Background

NXTFOOD PH (also known as Value Food Innovation Program or VFIP) is the most comprehensive and integrated government-led assistance program for the development and marketing of Philippine food products for the local and international market. Program participants benefit from interventions such as R&D, standard and product testing, labeling and packaging development, market testing, and content marketing and promotion. The output of the program answers the question "What's NXT in the world of FOOD?"

After the product launch last 22-24 Sept 2022 and the label design revealed last 26-28 May 2023 at the World Trade Center Metro Manila, product certification with the Philippines' Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is the next step in the program's journey. However, due to the three-year label design development by the partner, the one-year validity of the product analysis results, a requirement in the FDA-CPR (Certificate of Product Registration) together with the packaging and label designs, conducted with the DOST (Department of Science and Technology) last 2021 has already lapsed.

Thus, to ensure the program's continued service, it is imperative to engage the services of testing laboratory/ies that can conduct the microbiological and nutritional analysis of the 13 NXTFOOD PH products. The results of the analyses to be conducted shall be used as supporting documents in the FDA-CPR application of the products.

### II. Requirement and Scope of Services

1. Render professional services and conduct the microbiological and nutritional analysis based on the following parameters / analytes to support the FDA-CPR application:

- 2. Additional analytes or parameters may be added for testing by the laboratory as they deem appropriate based on Philippine FDA-CPR application requirements provided the complete list of analytes or parameters are included in their proposal and corresponding quotation.
- 3. Quantity and other terms for the sending of samples shall be determined by the laboratory/ies.
- 4. Reports to be generated must be on a per product basis reflecting the corresponding results of their microbiological and nutritional analysis.

### III. Qualifications of the Technical Provider

1. Must be a company based in the Philippines

- 2. Recognized and/or accredited by the Philippine Accreditation Bureau (PAB) with parameters based on Philippine FDA's standards
- 3. Has the absorptive capacity in terms of manpower, equipment and facilities, and schedule as stated below to undertake the project

The company profile and a certification from the PAB and/or its equivalent must be submitted.

### IV. Budget and Mode of Procurement
