Is the Valid Operational Permit issued by DOH a necessary requirement for a water refilling station? Can't a valid sanitary permit from Municipal Health Office be enough?	Per DOH advisory, operational permit is necessary to operate a water refilling station. It is very similar to a business permit. A written communication between the bidder and DOH showing that DOH indeed stated that sanitary permit already suffices may be provided.
Is the Certified True Copy of Potability of Drinking Water, is referring to the laboratory results?	A Certificate of Potability of Drinking Water is different from Laboratory Results. The certificate should be issued by the DOH.
For the Secretary Certificate/Partnership resolution, should the content indicate that the company has authorized a representative to participate in the bidding process?	Yes.

Items not mentioned above remain the same.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is being issued to clarify/modify/amend the specifications of the requirement needed, and not for purposes of delaying the proceedings of RA 9184.
