- Revision or Amendments:
 - 7.1. The provision of additional guests room/s and/or food that may be requested by the CENTER FOR INTERNATIONAL TRADE EXPOSITIONS AND MISSION is subject to availability.
- 8. Cancellation, Rescheduling and Reduction
 - 8.1. The CENTER FOR INTERNATIONAL TRADE EXPOSITIONS AND MISSION may CANCEL or RESCHEDULE confirmed reservations provided the DAP Conference Center is notified of the same at least ten (10) working days prior to the reservation date.
