The applicable fee for the Bidding Documents is **Three Thousand Pesos (Php 3,000.00)**.

The definition of contracts similar to the Project shall be: **Laptop PC (Mid-End) and/or Laptop PC (Workstation)**.

**Statement of the Bidder's SLCC similar to the contract to be bid:**

- i. Name of the completed contract with contract date, period and amount, which should correspond to the required percentage of the ABC to be bid. The value is adjusted to the current prices using the Philippine Statistics Authority consumer price indices, when necessary;
- ii. For Goods, the relevant period or delivery date when the said SLCC was completed; end user's acceptance or official receipt(s) or sales invoice issued for the contract, if completed; and
- iii. Definition or description of the similar project or major categories of work.

**Statement of the Bidder of all its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started:**

- i. Names of outstanding contracts with other contracting party, i.e., Procuring Entity or private company allowed by the rules, contract date, period and amount or value; and
- ii. For Goods, kinds of Goods and dates of delivery.

**Clarifications:**

Please see attached Annex A for queries/clarifications received by the BAC and the BAC Secretariat during the pre-bid conference and through email with its corresponding reference in the Philippine Bidding Document for answers.

Items not mentioned above remain the same.

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is being issued to clarify/modify/amend the specifications of the requirement needed, and not for purposes of delaying the proceedings of RA 9184.

## ANNEX A: Queries and Clarifications

Query / Clarification	Answers
1. How much is the bid security in case a bidder is interested only in a particular lot (i.e. 1 lot only)?	The bid security is based on the ABC of the lot that the bidder is interested to bid.  <i>Please refer to Section III – Bid Data Sheet of the Philippine Bidding Document for more details.</i>
2. Are we required to provide SLCC for both requirements even if we only intend to bid for one (1) laptop?	The SLCC, including its required amount, shall be based on the lot the bidder will participate in. Please see above revised definition of “contracts similar to the Project”.
3. If the award is on a per lot basis, will the submission of the eligibility documents be separately submitted as well?	Bidders have the option to submit a separate eligibility and proposal on any or all lots. The evaluation and contract award shall be undertaken on a per lot basis.
4. For the Statement of All Ongoing Government and Private contracts, do we need to submit or attach supporting documents?	For the Statement of All On-going Contracts, bidders are required to provide the following information: i. Names of outstanding contracts with other contracting party, i.e., Procuring Entity or private company allowed by the rules, contract date, period and amount or value; and ii. For Goods, kinds of Goods and dates of delivery.
5. Is 11th Gen or higher but low GHz accepted?	11th Gen is accepted. <i>Please refer to the Revised Section VII – Technical Specifications for the updated specifications.</i>
6. Will you consider the dealership certification issued by the Authorized Distributor of the brand that we will offer? Can we include manufacturer warranty or supplier's warranty?	No. Both laptops require manufacturer warranty.
7. Can you add lists of Service Center in the bidding docs?	Laptop brand must have adequate authorized service centers (provide list of service centers). There's no required number of adequate service center. <i>Please refer to the Revised Section VII – Technical Specifications for the updated specifications.</i>
8. Is there a minimum number requirement on the provision of service centers?	
9. Is offering a different brand (third party brand) for the laser mouse acceptable?	Yes. <i>Please refer to the Revised Section VII – Technical Specifications for the updated specifications.</i>
10. Is the mouse warranty for One (1) year?	Yes. <i>Please refer to the Revised Section VII – Technical Specifications for the updated specifications.</i>
11. Is it okay that HD for anti-glare is minimum?	Yes. <i>Please refer to the Revised Section VII – Technical Specifications for the updated specifications.</i>
12. Can we transition to single storage like 1TB SSD?	It's okay if there's a higher type of display and/or SSD.
13. Can the delivery period be adjusted from “45 to 60 days” to “90 to 120 days”?	Yes. The Delivery Period is now 90 to 120 days upon receipt of notice to proceed. <i>Please refer to the Revised Section VII – Technical Specifications for the updated specifications.</i>
