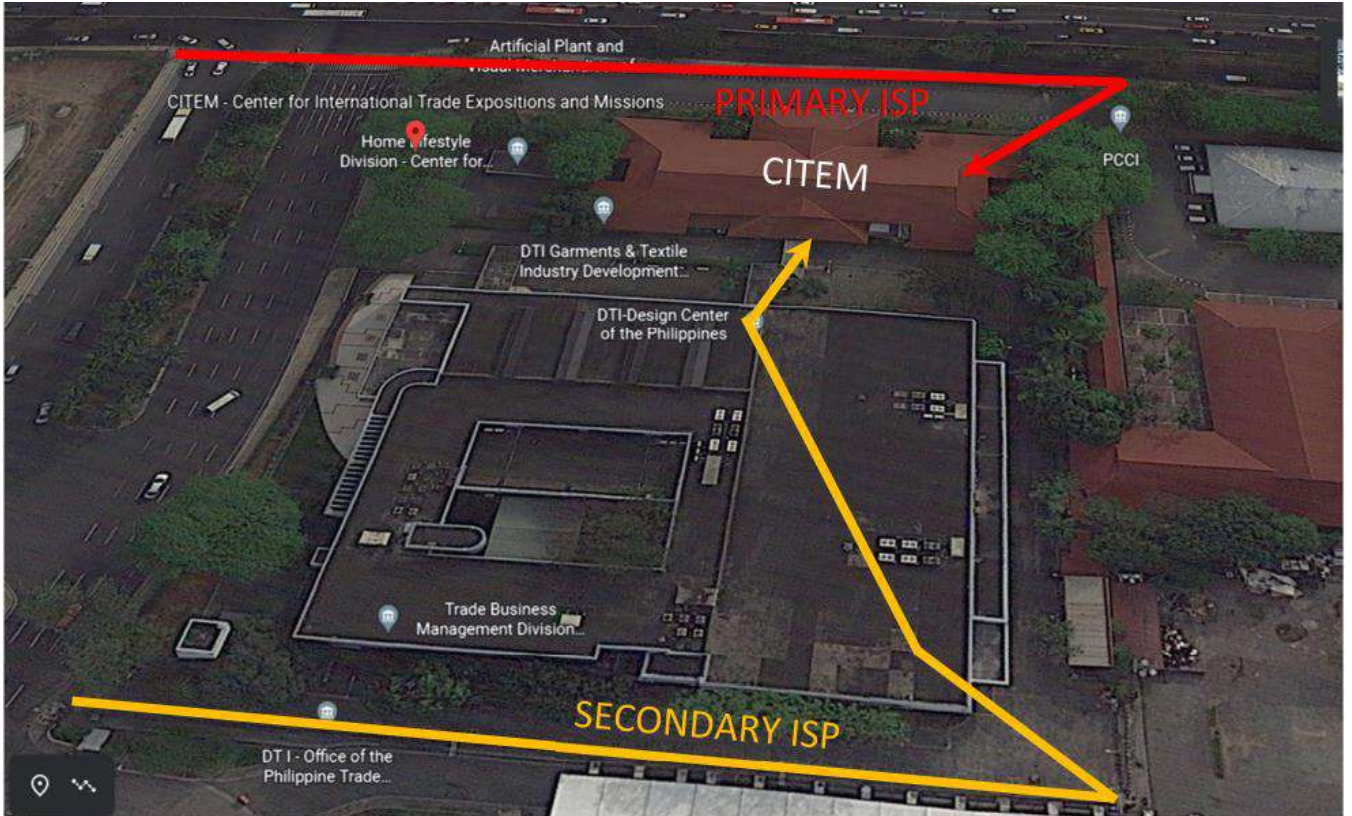

ANNEX A: Queries and Clarifications

QUERIES / CLARIFICATIONS	ANSWERS
What hosting service do you use? Application or Cloud based?	The hosting service will only be used for databases which must be provided by the winning ISP. Hosting service to be used is either application or cloud based.
If a provider is awarded for the primary internet service provider, is the winning provider can't be awarded for the secondary internet service provider? or vice versa?	Yes, different provider per leased line.
Are the existing provider allowed to bid for this year's ISP?	Yes.
Who is the host of the current SMTP access?	The secondary ISP provides SMTP access which can be used for sending transactional emails.
What will be the use of "Unlimited MySQL Database" for the Primary Line?	Will be used for offsite backup of our database.
Do you have an existing MySQL cloud license or server?	None. The winning primary ISP will provide the MySQL cloud license or server.
