SPACE CONTRACT REGULATIONS

These Regulations are to be read as an integral part of the Space Contract.

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

In these Regulations and in the Space Contract, the following words shall have the meaning respectively assigned to them hereunder, unless the context requires or admits otherwise:

Agreement' shall mean the Space Contract and these Regulations and the Exhibition Manual:

"Applicable Laws" shall mean the local laws and regulations of the Emirate of Dubai and the federal laws of the United Arab Emirates;

"Centre Users" shall mean of the exhibitors at the Centre, lenants of allocated spaces, and includes each of their agents, contractors, employees, invitees and attendees of the Exhibition:

"Exhibition" shall mean the event as named and dated in the Space Contract:

"Exhibitor" shall mean any person, firm, company, association, organisation and its employees, servants or agents to whom whibit space has been allocated for the purpose of exhibiting at the Exhibition; represented by the authorised signatory of this

"Contracted Term" shall mean the contracted period under the Agreement as specifically mentioned in the Space Contract;

"Exhibitor Manual" shall mean the manual of the Organiser's internel guidelines established from time to time and distributed to the Exhibitor prior to the Exhibition for the safe and orderly conduct and close of the Exhibition;

"Exhibition Material" shall mean such goods, exhibits, materials, equipment, stand/s, supplies, merchandise, models, exhibit items, or other property for the sole use of at the Exhibition;

"Force Majeure" shall mean any event or circumstances (or a combination of events or circumstances) which are beyond the combination of events or circumstances) which are beyond the reasonable control of the relevant Party, resulting in or causing the tailure by that Party to perform any of its obligations under this Agreement (whether in whole or in part), including without limitation; (1) revolution, nots, insurrection or other civil commotion, act of terrorism or sabotage or war; (2) nuclear explosion, radioactive, biological or chemical contamination, ionising, radiation or the identification of such contamination or radiation; (3) general sinkes, work stoppages, working to rule, go slow actions and/or lockouts;(4) any effect of the natural elements including lightening. fire, earthquakes, flood, storm, humcane, tsunami, cyclone or tomado, material change in sea level or coastal subsidence;(5) explosion (other than nuclear explosion or any explosion resulting from an act or war); (6) Inability to obtain necessary plant, equipment or material due to blockade, embarge or sanction;

"insurance Costs" means the costs of obtaining the mandatory insurance cover as prescribed in clause 12.1, and set out under the Particulars:

"Marketing Powerpack Costs" means (where applicable) fite costs of the powerpack or enhanced internet listing, if any provided by the Exhibitor as set out in clause 12.9 and under the Particulars;

"Objectionable Displays" shall mean any signage, products, services or show performance or literature could be considered offensive, immoral, contrary to the Applicable Laws, or is politically, socially, racially, or religiously sensitive or such that may cause prejudice to Duñai or the U.A.E or their relations with other countries, trade bodies, associations, clients or is otherwise objectionable in the sole and discretionary opinion of the Omaniser: Organiser:

"Organiser" shall mean the Dubal World Trade Center L.L.C

"Refund" shall mean by way of bank transfer or credit note, which shall be issued on such terms and conditions as deemed reasonable by the Organiser, taking into account all relevant surrounding circumstances at such time and acting in a good faith manner. In this regard, the Organiser shall reserve the right, acting in its reasonable discretion, to deduct direct costs actually and reasonably incurred in order to organise the Exhibition.

"Registration Fees" shall mean the fee set out under the

"Space Contract" means the Space Contract executed by the Organiser or Exhibitor and includes Schedule A attached thereto;

"Total Exhibition Fee" shall mean the sum payable by the Exhibitor to the Organiser in the amount and manner set out in Schedule A to these Regulations (and for the avoidance of doubt shall include the Insurance Costs, Registration Fee and Marketing Powerpack Costs and/orEnhanced Internet Listing); and

"VAT" means value added tax or sales tax and any other tax of a similar nature imposed in any jurisdiction; and

'Venue' shall mean the Dubai International Convention and Exhibition Centre, or such other venue owned or operated by the Organiser and identified in the Space Contract.

The Organiser reserves the sole right to alter the allocated exhibit space position if deemed necessary and in the best interests of the Exhibition in order to provide a viable layout. The Organiser's decision on such re-allocation of exhibit space shall be finel and

- The Total Exhibition Fee stated in the Space Contract are exclusive of any applicable taxes. CANCELLATION 4.

- 4.1 The Exhibitor shall immediately inform the Organiser in writing of its intention not to utilise the exhibit space contracted for. In the event that no notice is provided whatsoever to the Organiser hereunder then the Exhibitor shall indemnify the Organiser for all costs associated with it's non compliance with this provision (including loss of profit and consequential losses).

All distribution of literature must take place from within the boundaries of the Exhibitor's exhibit space and not in the gangways or any other area within the Venue. Any Exhibitor who continues to cause a nuisance or obstruction after hotics has been given will be liable to have their exhibit space cleared by the Organiser at the Exhibitor's own risk and expense.

WARRANTY

WARRANTY
The Exhibitor represents, warrants and undertakes that it is entering into this Agreement as principal and not as agent or nominee of any third party, and that the Exhibition Material does not intringe or is likely to infringe any patent, trademerk, copyright and ofter intellectual property right of any patent, trademerk, copyright in the event of any breach of the representations, warranties and undertakings herein contained, this Agreement may be terminated by the Organises, and the Exhibitor shall indemnify the Organiser against any and all costs, claims, demands, losses. Itabilities, charges, actions, and expenses arising from such termination due to the Exhibitor's breach.

SOUND LEVEL

The sound level of audio equipment must be timed to an acceptable volume and conducted in a way which does not interfere with nor becomes a nuisence to neighbouring exhibitors. The Organisers reserve the right to monitor, and where necessary, determine the acceptable level of sound of equipment, entertainment and audio visual presentations. If the Exhibitor continues to refuse to comply with the request to reduce the volume, the Organiser reserves the right to disconnect all power supplies to the exhibit space and no compensation will be made to the Exhibitor. supplies to the the Exhibitor.

A party shall not be in breach of this Agreement nor be liable for any failure or delay in performance of any obligations thereunder arising from or attributable to an event of Force Majeure (with the

If an event of Force Majeure occurs and written notice is served, then the Organiser may terminate this Agreement by written notice and the provisions of Clause 4.6 above shall apply. In the event of the termination of this Agreement pursuant to Force Majeure, neither party shall be liable to the other for any loss or demand of our netwer or kind whatever a referral as a result of or damage of any nature or kind whatsoever suffered as a result of such termination.
